READ-UNDERSTAND: Ephesians 4:1-3

- Understanding what Christ has done for us to be able to be "called according to His purpose" --What are some ways we are living a life worthy of that calling?
- Who are the people in our lives that we need to approach with humility, patience, gentleness, and love to restore unity and peace?

Ephesians 4:4-13

- According to this passage, what is the responsibility of the church leadership? What are they called to do?
- What is your spiritual gift? How are you using it?

Ephesians 4:14-16

- In what ways have you been tossed back and forth in your faith?
- How can we become more mature in our faith?

APPLY-SHARE: What should I do now and who else needs to hear it?

- What do you need to change or do based on what we learned?
- What are some specific ways to talk about this with others?
