READ: Philippians 1:27-30 <u>Step 4</u>: *List some key words:*

Step 1: underline nouns

<u>Step 2</u>: double underline verbs <u>Step 3</u>: circle descriptive words

Snapshot: Philippians is a letter written by the Apostle Paul around A.D. 53-59. Paul is writing to Christians in Philippi about spiritual growth and having joy in the face of suffering.

Discussion Guide

READ-UNDERSTAND:

Philippians 1:27

- What are some ways we justify our actions based on the difficulty of the situation? How does it hinder us from doing what is right?
- What are some ways we can train (or prepare) ourselves to be ready to do what is right ("worthy of the gospel") in any situation?

Philippians 1:28

- How can handling difficult situations alone be dangerous? Talk about a time when you handled something alone and it would have been better to seek help.
- What do you think it looks like to "stand firm in one Spirit, striving together as one for the faith of the gospel"?
- What type of opposition in life scares you?
- (v.28b) How does standing firm, striving for faith and not being afraid show people around you they need Christ?

Philippians 1:29-30

• Looking back, how do you see your suffering as being "granted to you" by God?

APPLY-SHARE: What should I do now and who else needs to hear it?
