READ: James 5:7-11

Snapshot: James, also known as James the Just, was one of the brothers of Jesus. He was the leader of the Jerusalem church until his death in A.D. 62. James wrote his letter in A.D. 40-45 to the Jewish believers that were scattered throughout Palestine. Purpose: Applying God's Word

READ-UNDERSTAND:

James 5:7-8

- How does knowing that most things are not in your control help you to be patient?
- Read 2 Peter 3:9. How does should the fact that God is patient with you help you to be patience with others?

James 5:9

- In what ways do we grumble against one another?
- Read Philippians 2:14-16. When believers grumble and argue with each other, what does that show the unbelieving world?

James 5:10-11

- Read Hebrews 11:32-38. How does the suffering in this passage compare to your suffering?
- Read Romans 5:1-4. What is God's goal in allowing or causing suffering in our lives?

APPLY-SHARE: *What should I do now and who else needs to hear it?*
